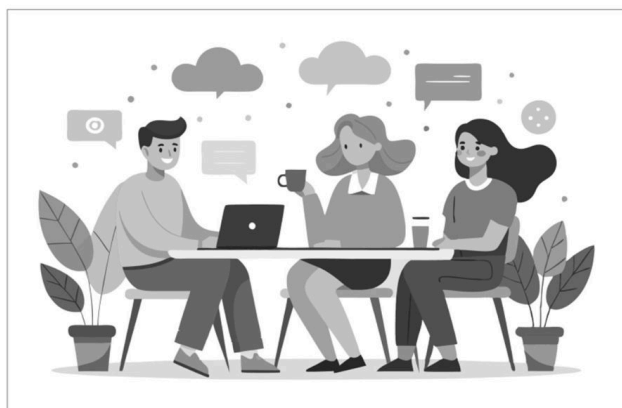
BOYS & GIRLS CLUB IS BACK
